




Remember Calvary!

Dear Friends,

Greetings in the name of our Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ. It is with great joy that I give report of a successful right knee replacement surgery! Things went well every step of the way. Susan and I have been back on the road for a month and are currently in our fifth revival meeting since March 25th. Everyday my knee is doing better. I'm still dealing with stiffness and swelling after I preach, but I'm told that is to be expected. I know this: the pain I have been dealing with for many years is gone and I praise the Lord for that!

I also praise the Lord for the Dayton, Ohio VA hospital and staff. I could not have asked for better care. They bent over backwards to help in every way they could, paid the bill, and then thanked me for letting them do it! The VA has a lot of critics, and no doubt rightfully so on some occasions, but I am not one of them. Again, at the end of the day I praise the Lord for His continued grace to me. I thank the many saints that communicated with us that they were making this a matter of prayer. I also want to thank those that helped us financially during this downtime. This was a concern initially because outside of some monthly support, for which we are most grateful, if an evangelist isn't working, he isn't getting paid. All of our bills were met, and then some. Susan and I are humbled by the grace we have been shown by God's people and we can't thank you enough.

We hit the ground running on March 22, heading to Panama City, Florida for a meeting, then up to the Carrollton, Georgia area. Both meetings were a blessing to us after being home all winter. From Georgia we drove to rural Missouri for a fruitful revival meeting in Irondale. 24-year-old Victoria, 12-year-old Collin, and 21-year-old Kody came to Christ that week! On the last day of the meeting I preached to 50 teenagers in the library of a public high school and 5 made professions of faith! The fourth revival was in Wooster, Ohio, and 3 boys got saved at a local juvenile detention center. I finished the fifth meeting last night in Dillsboro, Indiana. 18-year-old Hannah walked the aisle to receive Christ as her Saviour! Glory to God!

The time at our home church and with family members was a blessing, but needless to say we are excited about being back on the road where we belong! Also, there has been some renewed interest in my memoir, Bikin' and Brotherhood: My Journey and God has laid it on my heart to finish the sequel, tentatively titled Good Book Reforms Bad Biker. That was the headline on the front page of the Dayton Daily News, December 30, 1991. That article, published a month after I was sentenced to 5 years probation and 1000 hours of community service telling others how I got off dope, liquor, and out of a lawless lifestyle, put the Gospel of Jesus Christ into 450,000 homes on New Year's Eve!
