

Dear Praying Friends,

Greetings in the name of our Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ. The Lord has kept Susan and I very busy since the last letter. In July we were in a meeting in Missouri where Dakota, 25 years old, got saved on the first day. That set the stage for a great meeting with much liberty to preach the rest of the week.

At a campground in South Sioux City, Nebraska, a group of ten bikers on their way to South Dakota camped next to us for several days. They were going to the annual motorcycle rally in Sturgis and needed to make some necessary repairs. I was surprised to find out they were all from Brazil. About half of them spoke good enough English for me to witness to them, give them tracts, and pray with them before they headed west. I even gave their leader a copy of my book.

Three meetings in Minnesota resulted in a nineteen year old man getting saved. The next revival was in Amarillo, followed by three more in Colorado. A twenty-nine year chiropractor got saved on a Friday night in Denver in October. From Colorado we drove back to Ohio to prepare to fly to California for a month. We were in four churches out there as well as going street preaching a couple of times, preaching a Veterans Day Ceremony at a convalescent care center, and a church service at a Job Corp facility in Imperial Beach. Altogether, fifteen adult souls came to Christ during the west trip. In my Bible, next to John 4:35, I wrote, "California".

Back in Ohio I learned that Richland Correctional Institute in Mansfield is still closed to me, however another facility in the eastern part of the state has expressed the desire to have me come and preach to the inmates there. I would appreciate prayer for the opportunities to preach in both of these prisons.

I want to mention that Susan has done fifteen Ladies meetings so far this year. Pastors call and ask me to ask her if she would be willing to speak to the ladies of their church. My response is always, "I don't have to ask her. She would be more than happy to. That's what God has called us to do." I highly recommend considering taking advantage of her forty-eight years of faithfulness in the Lord to encourage the ladies of the churches we go to.

I requested renewed prayer concerning my Presi dential Pardon in my last prayer letter. Many have asked if I'd heard anything about it. So far, I have not, but thank you for your prayers. I have enclosed the original letter with the addresses again, should anyone feel led to write a letter.

I turned "35" in the Lord on November 30th. I still marvel that the Lord would save me, and at how fast the time has gone by since that day. Thank you all for your faithful prayers and support of this ministry. As is often said, and is absolutely true, we could not do what we do without you.
