Dear Praying Friends,

Greetings in the name of our Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ. First of all, thank you to everyone who sent up a prayer on behalf of our niece, Joanna Edwards. She is the wife of Caleb Edwards, of the Gentile Ministry to Israel, and the mother of three precious children. Joanna is 32 years old and was diagnosed with stage 4 cancer last January. She went through the chemo like a trooper, and recently finished radiation. She made it into the 5% to be declared "cancer free," and she knows it is a direct result of Christians praying. Again, Susan and I thank you, and Joanna and her family thank you for praying for her. And, if you don't mind, keep her on your list of survivors, if you would.

During meetings in May and July seven people made professions of faith. Susan also addressed the ladies a number of times. August began with nine inmates getting saved in the course of three Sunday afternoon services in the Charlevoix County Jail in northern Michigan! Preaching six times made for a long day, but it was well worth it!

In the last letter I requested prayer concerning my application for a Presidential Pardon. Final disposition on my request could take a year or more. My official status on the Department of Justice website is "Pending." Maybe it should read "Depending." That is, "depending" on whether or not God sees fit to let me have one. Or "depending" on whether or not enough folks pray that He will. I'm a winner either way. The Gospel is clear in the pardon application, and I gave the Lord Jesus Christ all the credit for changing my life.

Thank you to all who sent in the "Please Pardon David Spurgeon" postcards. Many have communicated that they did, and I am humbled by your support. If a majority of the four thousand cards I had printed make it to Washington DC, my file should attract attention just by virtue of it's size alone. A short letter would be even better. I am again enclosing the two addresses, should you feel so led.
